The minor in Deaf Studies at UVSC consists of 21 credits of upper division course work. Each student's course of study must include all three of the courses making up the "Core Requirement" (9 credits). Students then choose one of three courses listed under "Core Elective Requirement" (3 credits). Finally, students may choose from any other upper division ASL courses (as well as any others listed below) to satisfy the "Elective Requirement" (9 credits).

#### **Core Requirement (9 Credits)**

Complete *each* of the following three courses.
